The first family, we'll call the Donner family, has two boys and a girl and their ages are 12, 7, and 5 respectively. The 12 year old boy would like medium pants 30, 32 and shoes size 11. He is interested in football and Star Wars. The second young man needs shoe size 1 and interested in sports and Beyblades. The young lady needs winter clothing size 6/7 and her shoe size is 11. She is interested in animals, crafts and dolls.

The second family, we'll call the Blitzen family, The seven year old boy has interest in Hot Wheels, Pokemon, Leggos, and a remote control truck. The 11 year old girl's interests are in drawing and crafts pokemon, 3d pen, art set drawing pads, and Leggos.

All non-perishable foods can be utilized. The Foodbank is most in need of:

Basic Foods

Hearty Soups

- Stews (Beef, Chicken and Dumplings)
- Chili
- Peanut Butter and Jelly
- Macaroni and Cheese

Meat/High Protein Group

- Canned meats: ham, chicken, meat spreads
- Canned fish including tuna, salmon, sardines, other fish
- Nuts, and seeds
- Rice and Beans

Dairy Group

- Evaporated milk
- Powdered milk
- Puddings & custards

Fruits & Vegetables

- Canned fruits: peaches, pears, pineapples, applesauce, fruit cocktail
- Canned juices: apple, cranberry, tomato and vegetable
- Canned vegetables: green beans, peas, corn, tomatoes, potatoes

Breads, Cereals & Pasta

- Hot and cold breakfast cereals, including oatmeal and cream of wheat
- Baking mixes: pancake, corn bread, cake mixes/icing, quick breads
- Pastas and canned sauces

Other items-

Pet Food (yes, needy families have pets too!)

- Cat and dog dry and canned food

Non-food Household products:

- Paper – toilet, tissues and towels
- Soap – Bar and liquid
- NOTE: Must be boxed and stored separately from all food items
